### Verse 3

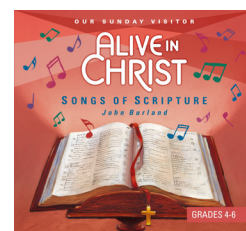
“I will give you the courage and power

### Verse 3

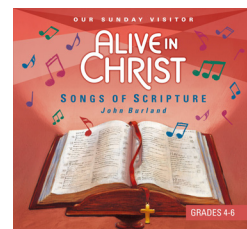
And so Jesus came to John on that day.

### Verse 3

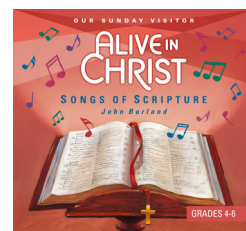
They had gathered in the upper room.

### Verse 4

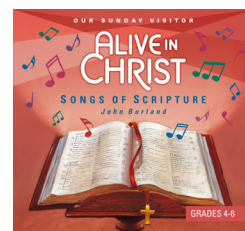
God is our Father, no matter what we do.

His presence within us strengthens us to love.

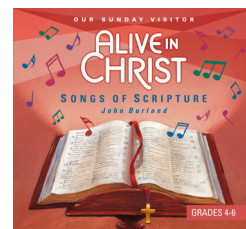
We are sent into the world to serve in his name.

them a new way.

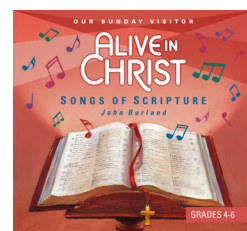
### Verse 3

We are now his disciples called to witness everywhere.

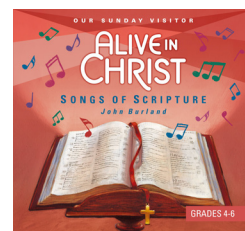
